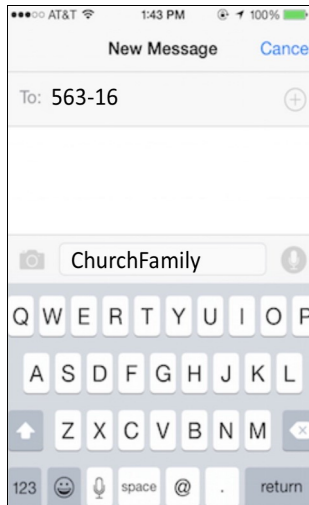

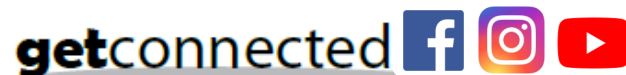

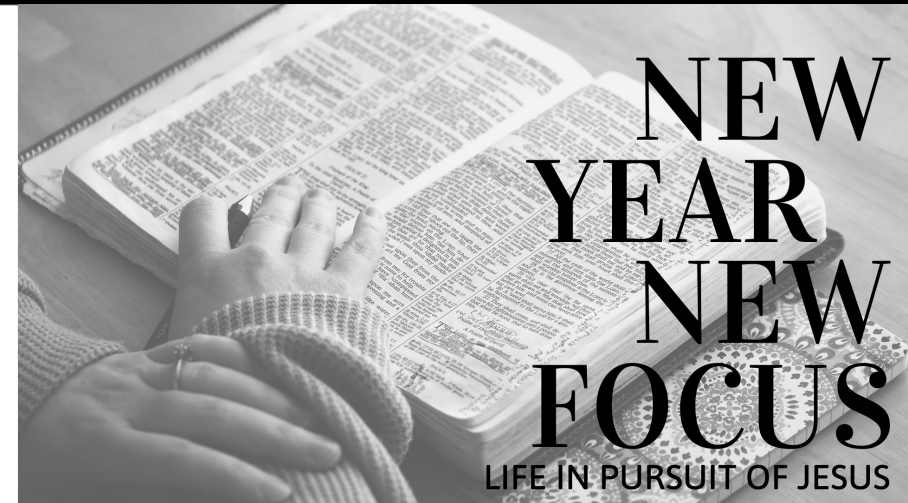

What Is Communion?

Communion or the Lord’s Supper is also known as the Eucharist. It’s a practice that has been a part of Christian churches for over 2,000 years! There are various ways it has been practiced, but everyone agrees that it’s highly important for the Christian to participate, as it was Jesus, Himself, who asked us to participate (Luke 22:7-22). What should we do during communion? First, we should look back. Communion is a time to remember what Christ accomplished for us. We are reminded of His love and sacrifice for our sins. Second, we should look ahead. The Bible says we are to do this “until He comes again” (1Corinthians 11:26). By faith we put our hope in the promise that one day He will return; not as a suffering servant, but as a reigning King! Third, communion is a time to look within. We invite the Holy Spirit to show us areas in our lives where we are not right with Him. We acknowledge our sins and embrace the forgiveness that He offers. It’s a time of honesty, reverence and joy! It’s a great time to renew our commitment to Christ or even make a commitment to Christ for the first time!
